TERMS AND CONDITIONS

In response to the International Convention on Biological Diversity (Rio de Janeiro 1992), Stavanger Botanical garden and Rogaland Arboretum supply seeds to other botanical gardens and research institutions on the following conditions:

- 1) The seeds are used for the common good in the areas of research, education, conservation and the development of botanical gardens;
- 2) Permission is sought from Stavanger Botanic Garden or Rogaland Arboretum if the recipient seeks to commercialise the genetic material, its products or research derived from it. Such commercialization will be subject to the conditions of a separate agreement with the country of origin.
- 3) The genetic material, its products or research derived from it are not passed on to a third party for commercialization without permission from Stavanger Botanical Garden or Rogaland Arboretum.
- 4) That scientific publications resulting from use of plant material supplied by Stavanger Botanic Garden or Rogaland Arboretum acknowledge these institutions as suppliers. In addition, these publications are expected to be sent to the garden.
