

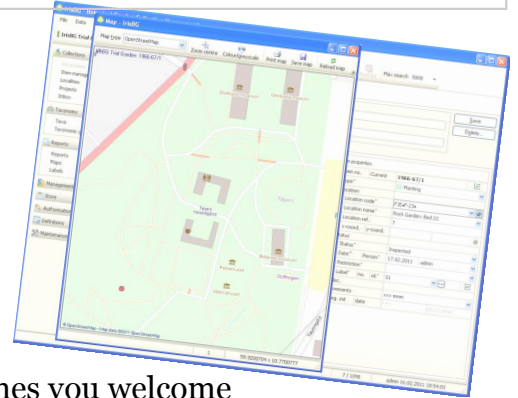

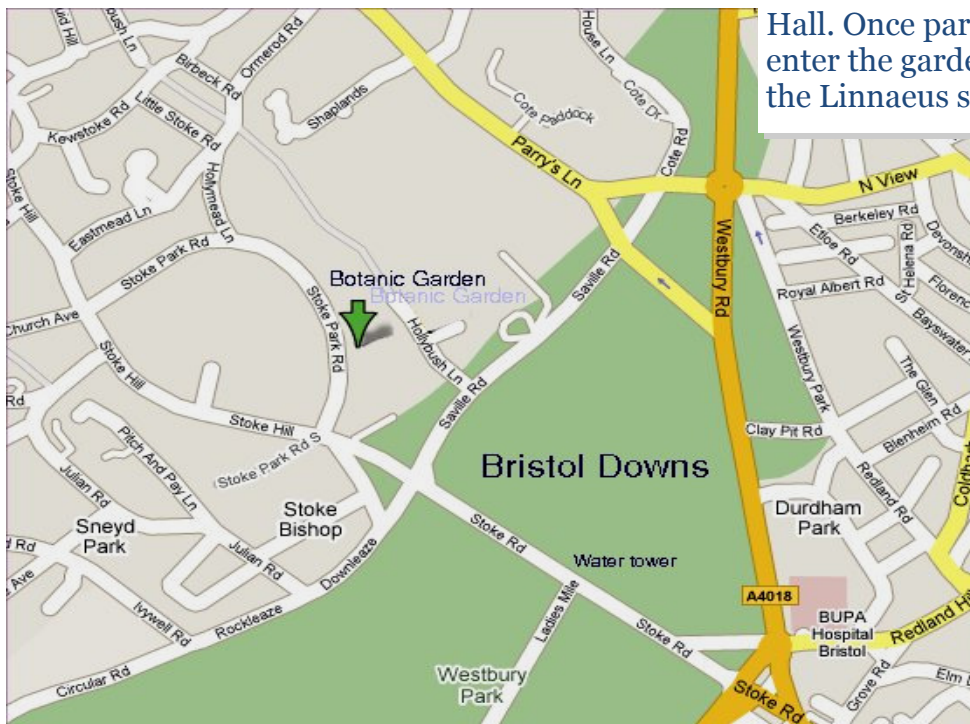

### Venue

#### University of Bristol Botanic Garden

Due to essential building works, there is no parking in the Botanic Garden. Parking is available outside on Stoke Park Road and opposite at Churchill Hall. Once parked, attendees should enter the garden and follow signs for the Linnaeus study room.



The garden is located opposite Churchill Hall. Limited parking is available in the car park on site and out of term time at Churchill Hall. On entering the Garden keep to the right with the Welcome Lodge to your left and walk diagonally across the walled Garden car park. Go through the gateway (you will see the glass-houses ahead) and follow the path round to your left. The Linnaeus Study Room is ahead on your right.

**Public transport:** Take bus No.40 from City Centre to Stoke Bishop, alight at top of Stoke Hill; from Temple Meads Station take Nos. 1 or 54. Alight at White Tree Roundabout and walk along Saville Road to Stoke Hill. Take first right into Stoke Park Road and entrance is 200m on the right.

**From the city centre** proceed across Downs (with the water tower on your right). Cross over at the traffic lights. Stoke Park Road is the first main turning on the right off Stoke Hill.

**From the M5** exit at Junction 17 (Cribbs Causeway) and follow signs for city centre and Zoo until you reach the Downs. Turn right at first roundabout on Downs (Parry's Lane) then first left into Saville Road to Stoke Hill. Turn right at traffic lights (top of Stoke Hill).
