- Purchased 2 Galaxy Tab S4 + Otter box April 2018




## Training

### Training

### Use

**Carrying:** Some carry all the time but many just carry them when they think they will need them. Also depends on work being carried out.

**Frequency of use:** Very section specific. Some daily others seasonal and some had not used at all.

**Usefulness:** Positive. It changes the way people work. Like using barcode scanner in nursery. Will become even more useful once we roll out barcodes to our engraved labels.

**Use:** Updating Items, ordering labels, creating tasks, looking up records. Removing the need to use paper to write things down and then remember to update.
